

Folk Dance Remixed Technical Spec 2019



Step Hop House is a dynamic and fast moving performance with live music at its very heart.

The set consists of:

A steel Maypole (height: 3.36m, base: 1m sq. with a thick foam covering, crown & ribbons: approx. 4.5m long, requiring a total diameter of 10m min.), sandbags for weights, a large red rope for performance area demarcation and 7 small portable wooden dance boards.

Description:

- The Maypole is central to both the performance and the layout of the show. It has a total spread of around ten meters, and that defines everything else. At the start of the show the base of the Maypole will be pre-set, and the rope and small coloured sandbags will define the performance circle and where the dance boards will be placed by the performers as they enter.
- The PA is spread quite wide of the performance area. The musicians are very much part of the show and will wander all over the performance area.

Technical Specifications:

YOU will provide:

FOH: Sufficient for the space and audience anticipated. It is essential it has sufficient bass, so a rig comprising of at least sub-bass and mid-high cabinets, actively crossed over is essential.

WE will provide:

A mixer, cables, stands, microphones and DI boxes.

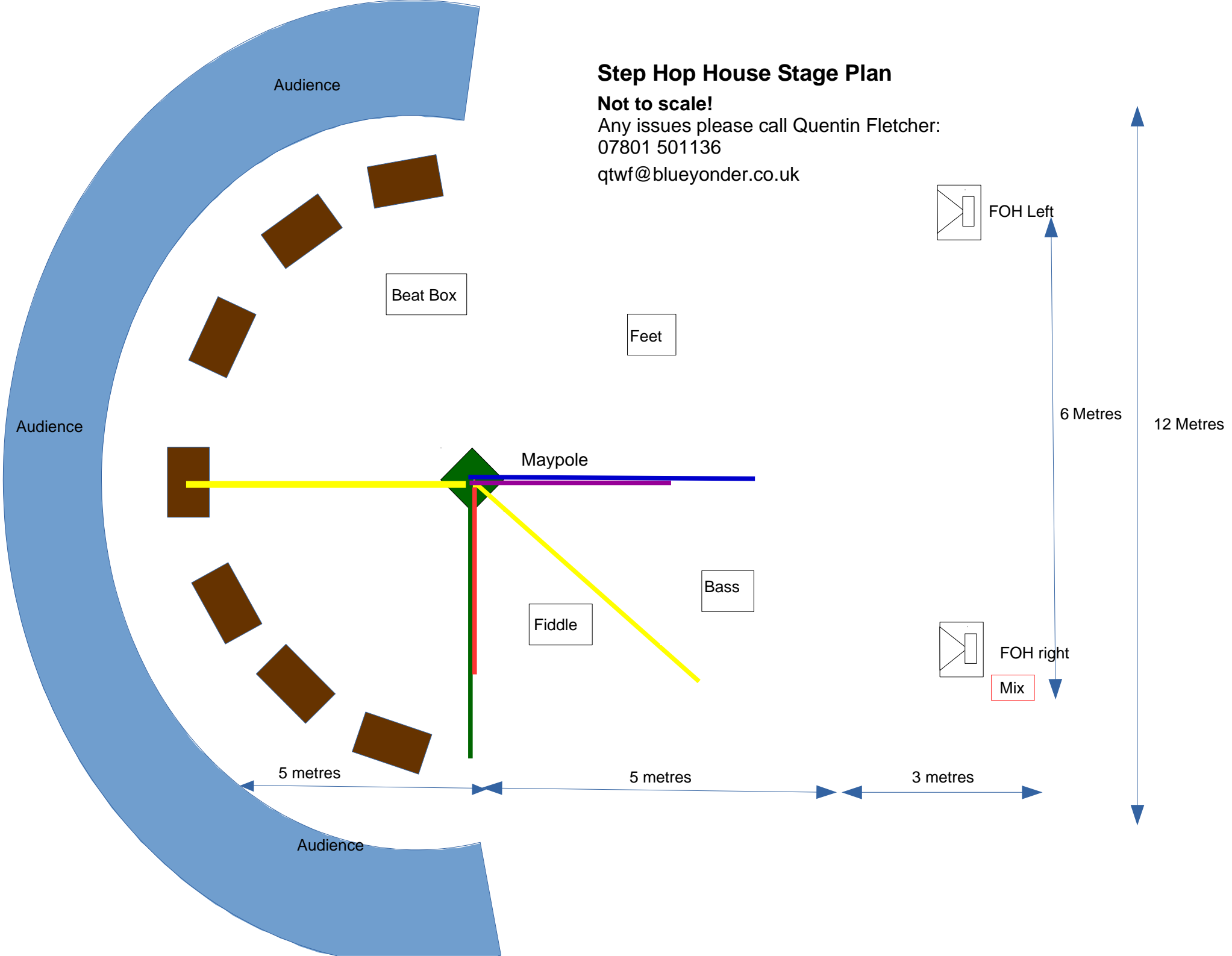
We will provide 6 channels of radio microphones, and three channels of In-Ear-Monitors, on channels 38 and 70, which must be kept clear for the duration of the show.

Ceilidh Jam Stage Plan

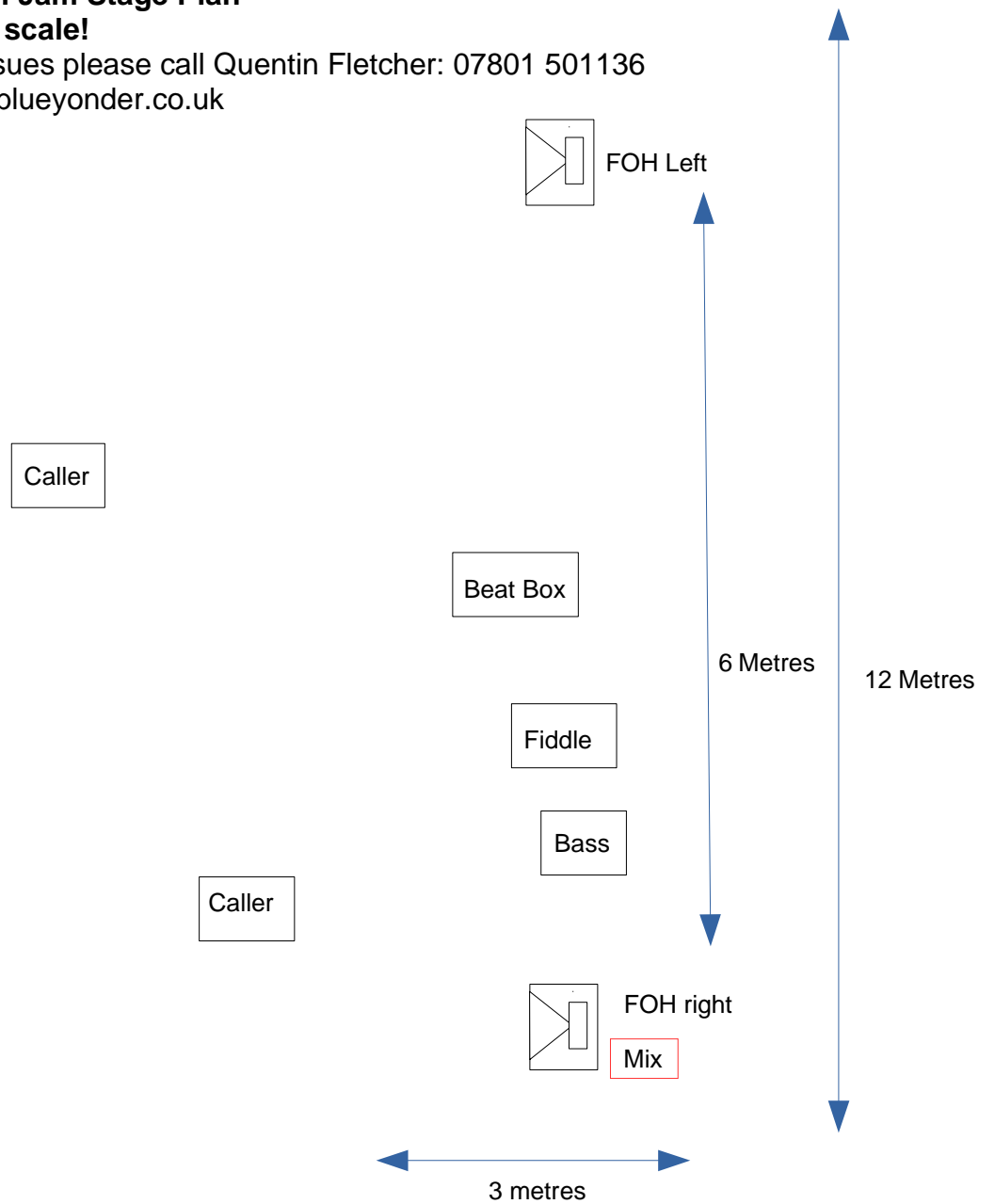
