Arrival

Airport Arrivals

To make your travel from Birmingham Airport (BHX) to Birmingham New Street straight forward we would recommend you take the train. Birmingham Airport is directly connected to Birmingham International train station by a free Air-Rail Link system which takes 2 minutes to get to the station. Air-rail pictured below.



From Birmingham International Station there are a number of regular trains that stop at Birmingham New Street which is on average 10-20 minute journey. You can find these trains leaving Birmingham International roughly every 10 minutes.

Car

Birmingham Clean Air Zone launched on 1st June 2021, charges will be applied daily. A noncompliant vehicle driving within the Zone will pay once per day, and may drive without limit on that day. Uber

If travelling by car/uber the journey is roughly 11 miles taking 20 minutes. Ubers are readily available from the station heading into Birmingham city centre.

Practicalities // DanceXchange

There are some things you need to know about your time with us. We will go through most of this when you arrive but just in case we miss anything or you have any questions, here's the information you need to know.

Passports

Due to Home Office regulations, please ensure that you have uploaded passport information to Eventotron to prove your right to work. If not uploaded, we need to see and take copied of all non-UK residents' passports. Please make sure you have these ready at your company get in at your performance venue.

Personal Items

DanceXchange cannot accept any liability for damage to, loss or theft of personal property on its premises. We strongly advise you not to leave money or valuables unattended at any time.

Accidents and First Aid

Please report any accidents to a member of staff and we can then, if necessary, locate a First Aid trained member of the team to assist. If you require plasters, ice packs and so on please ask a member of staff who will be happy to help.

Fire Evacuation Procedure

It is important to familiarise yourself with the fire escape routes and alarm points. Please do not leave anything, including props and costumes, in corridors or other escape routes.

The Festival wants to ensure we keep all company members and staff on site safe. We request every person take a Lateral Flow Test every 48 hours whilst with us at the Festival and on site. These tests will be provided by the Festival once you arrive to site.

Accessibility

Our wonderful team of staff, Front of House assistants and volunteers are available for assistance during your visit to the Festival. We are happy to chat with you ahead of your visit to make you feel comfortable and at home during your time with us.

We work from the Social Model of Disability, which, by focusing on the disabling barriers imposed by society, embraces all physical, sensory and invisible impairments, learning disability, mental health, neurodivergent and fatigue conditions. Some of our core staff members have attended Disability Awareness training but we always have more to learn, so please talk to us about your individual requirements so we can discuss how we can accommodate them.

Quiet spaces are available and all our Festival spaces both indoor and outdoor are wheelchair accessible, disability & assistance dog friendly.

Events & Performances

As part of our commitment to ensuring we deliver an inclusive and accessible Festival, we offer a range of access provisions and assisted performances.

BSL interpretation, captioning and audio description are available for some of our indoor and outdoor events. We also have a number of highly visual shows which contain few or no words and are particularly enjoyable without the aid of hearing. Performance Schedule

Meeting Point / Arrival Location

Upon arrival at each venue a member of the BIDF team will greet you and provide you with a lateral flow test. Each company member will need to take one of these every 48 hours during their time at the festival. Once checked they will take you to your allocated dressing room/holding space.

Please arrive no later than **1 hour** prior to your performance time. And ensure you arrive promptly for your allocated technical rehearsal.

Accommodation

PENTAHOTEL

Pentahotel is located less then a mile away from Birmingham City Centre, just a 10 minute walk from Birmingham New Street Station, 2 miles from junction 6 of the motorway and just 6 miles from Birmingham Airport. Pentahotel is only a 10 minute walk from DanceXchange and the Bullring Shopping Centre.

Pentahotel offers a limited number of onsite parking spaces at £4 p/h or £16 for 24 hours.



From New Street Station to Pentahotel -

Leave the train station via the Southside exit, continue straight onto Hill Street. (Accessible route: turn right at the top of the stairs, continue round to the ramp and follow this down or take the lift down, turn left onto Hill Street). At the end of the road turn right onto Smallbrook Queensway (Holiday Inn should be on your right). Continue on Smallbrook Queensway (you will come to the Radisson Blu Hotel on your right), cross over Suffolk Street Queensway, turn left after crossing and then head right towards Holloway Head. Cross over the road and turn right, Pentahotel should be on your left.



From Pentahotel to Hippodrome -

Address: Birmingham Hippodrome Theatre, Hurst Street, Southside, Birmingham, B5 4TB

By Car: (From Pentahotel)


Exit Pentahotel and turn right onto Holloway Head/B3127. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Bristol Street/A38. Follow the road straight and take the 3rd left onto Wrentham Street, then take the 2nd left onto Kent Street. Once on Kent Street take the 3rd left onto Hurst Street, the next left onto Bromsgrove Street, the next right onto Essex Street and the next and final turning onto Inge Street on your right. The Hippodrome is situated on this street on your left.

Birmingham Hippodrome is about a 5 minute drive from Pentahotel.

Parking:

Birmingham Hippodrome does not have its own car park although they can recommend The Arcadian Car Park, which is multi-storey. The address for this is 41 Bromsgrove Street, Birmingham, B5 6NU. They offer a Flat Rate for theatre-goers which is £6 when parking between 5pm and 7.30pm. This rate is valid until 11.30pm the same night. To get this rate, please pay when you arrive. The car park now uses vehicle registration recognition when you leave.

There is also additional pay & display parking available on Thorp Street (1 minute walk away from Hippodrome) and Hurst Street (4 minute walk away). For Thorp Street Car Park: Opening Times Mon-Sun 7am-12:00am up to 1 hour at £2.00, up to 2 hours at £4:00, up to 12 hours at £6.00 and up to 24 hours £12.50. For Hurst Street Car Park: Opening Times Mon-Sun up to 1 hour at £1.00, up to 2 hours at £2.00, up to 3 hours at £3.00, up to 4 hours at £4.00, up to 12 hours at £4.50 and up to 24 hours at £6.00.



By Bus:

Bus no 823 or 23 Platinum/24 Platinum runs from Stop HH2 every 5 minutes on Ernest Street outside of the hotel. The bus journey takes 2 minutes and stops a 2 minute walk from the Hippodrome at Smallbrook Queensway (Stop NS5).

From Pentahotel to Handsworth Park -

Address: Handsworth Park, Holly Road, Handsworth, B20 2BY

By Car: (From Pentahotel)


Exit Pentahotel and turn right onto Holloway Head/B3127. At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Suffolk Street Queensway, take the slip road on the right onto Suffolk Street Queensway/A38 continue to follow road for 0.7mi. Use the left lane to turn slightly left onto Great Charles Street Queensway/A4400. Turn left onto Old Snow Hill/B4100 and continue for 1mi, continue onto Soho hill/A41 for 0.6mi. Turn right on Whitehall Road, when you reach the end of the road turn left onto Holly Road, Handsworth Park & Car Park will be on your right.

Handsworth Park is roughly a 10 minute drive from Pentahotel.

Parking:

Free parking is available at Handsworth Car Park (B20 2BY) opening times are Mon-Fri 7am-7pm, Sat 8am-3pm, Sun 7am-4pm.

Pay & Display parking is available at <u>Baker Street Car Park</u> (B21 9LP) located just a 10 minute walk from Handsworth Park. Opening times Mon-Sat 24 hours, Sun 8am-6pm up to 2 hours at £1.10, up to 4 hours at £2.30, up to 24 hours at £4.50 – Sunday charges, up to 2 hours at £1, up to 10 hours at £2.



By Bus:

From the City Centre bus no 16 run regularly from Upper Dean Street (Stop MK3) just a 10 minute walk from Pentahotel. The bus journey takes around 17 minutes and stops just a 10 minute walk from Handsworth park, alight the bus at Handsworth Park Gates (13 stops).

Alternatively, bus no 101 runs regularly from Colmore Row (Stop SH3) located just a 15 minute walk from Pentahotel. The bus journey takes around 23 minutes and stops right outside Handsworth Park on Grove Lane, alight the bus at Handsworth Park (25 stops).

Accommodation

JURYS INN

Jurys Inn is located near the International Convention Centre and Birmingham Arena less than half an hour from Birmingham Airport and just a 15 minute walk from Birmingham New Street Station. Jurys Inn is around a 20 minute walk to DanceXchange and the Bullring Shopping Centre.

The nearest public car park is a 4 minute walk away at <u>Q-Park Brindleyplace</u> (B1 2JF) which offers 24 hour parking at £20.






From New Street to Jurys Inn -

Leave the train station via the Stephenson Street exit. Turn left onto Stephenson Street and continue left onto Navigation Street. You will reach a bridge with a sign that reads 'Mailbox', walk under the bridge and then turn right, when you come to the road turn left onto Holliday Street. Continue on Holliday Street until you reach a small roundabout, turn right at the roundabout onto Berkley Street (CBSO Centre should be on your left), when you reach the end of the road Jurys Inn entrance will be on your left.




From Jurys Inn to Centenary Square -

Exit Jurys Inn and turn right onto Broad Street, continue until you reach the ICC which will be on your left. Walk in front of the ICC and turn right, Centenary Square is in front of The Birmingham REP.




Map of City Centre locations: Victoria Square, Chamberlain Square & Centenary Square

Local Shops

There are a number of small shops you can find in the city centre.

Tesco Express - Caxton Gate, New St, Birmingham B2 5AE

There is a big Tesco as you exit Birmingham New Street Station onto Stephenson Street. Walking straight ahead, passing Archie's and The Shakespeare pub on your left and Starbucks on your right you will see the Tesco Express right in front of you.

Sainsbury's Local - 10 Brindley Place, Birmingham B1 2JB

This Sainsbury's local is right opposite Jurys Inn Hotel, located on Broad Street. If Jurys Inn is on your left, this Sainsbury's will be just ahead on your right.

Corner shops

There is one corner shop **Sandhu Newsagent & Off Licence** right next to Handsworth park on Holly Road (on the side of the park with the play area). It is on the corner of Holly Road and Thornhill Road.

There are a number of corner shops available on Soho Road about a 15 minute walk away from the park.
