The festival is open to the public from 12-6pm.

The festival takes place at **The Highlight, Hartlepool, TS24 0YA**, the former site of Jackson's Landing retail outlet for those familiar with Hartlepool.

There will be a variety of stage performances, art installations, outdoor performances, workshops on offer throughout the day, along with an arts market and food traders.

From 4.15pm, we will screen Finding Nemo (Saturday) and Finding Dory (Sunday) to respond to our theme of 'When the Boat Comes In' which explores arrivals & departures, homecomings and more.

Arrival

You may access the site from Friday 8th July, between 3pm-6pm. Overnight security will be present.

You may also access the site on the morning of the festival weekend from 9am-11am.

Arrival will likely have been agreed in advance over e-mail. The above is general information.

On your approach, to 'The Highlight', turn right (third exit) at the first roundabout and head through the first yellow gate on your right for Artist parking. A map of this can be found at the bottom of this document.

You are also welcome to drive onto the site within the allotted times above. Vehicles on site must stick to a speed limit of 5mph with hazard lights-on.
